



## Attention Early Childhood Education Majors!

Thinking about finishing your Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree in Child Development at a 4-year Institution?

California State University Long Beach (CSULB) will be offering an extension program at Santa Monica College (SMC) that will allow SMC students who are majoring in ECE to complete a BA degree from CSULB!

Take classes at SMC, but earn your BA from CSU Long Beach!

### TO QUALIFY FOR THIS PROGRAM, YOU MUST:

- Be General Education (GE) CERTIFIED (CSU GE or IGETC).
- Have a GPA (Grade Point Average) of 2.4 or better in all transferable units.
- Have completed at least 56 transferable semester units.
- Have been in good standing with SMC.

### COST

\$200 per unit (each class = 3 units)

(SMC is currently working with CSULB to articulate several of SMC's Early Childhood Education courses so that they will transfer over as lower division units at CSULB. Stay tuned!)
