



## Recommended Priorities for Future Funding for General Child Care and Development Services

The Child Care Planning Committee compiled the following data at the census tract and/or zip code level:

- 1) Number of children, zero-to-three, three-through-five, and six-to-twelve years old in working families whose incomes are less than 75% of the State Median Income (SMI) extrapolated from the 2000 Census data and updated with data from the American Community Survey (2006).
- 2) Number of children (infants, preschool-age, and school-age) who are served in a California Department of Education/Child Development Division (CDE/CDD) program by resident zip codes. The programs include: Alternative Payment, center-based, Family Child Care Home Education Network, CalWORKs Stages 2 and 3, full-day State Preschool, and Latchkey. These numbers, provided by CDE/CDD staff, were compiled with information from contractors' reports from April 2007. In addition, for school-age, the count of After School Education and Safety (ASES) and 21<sup>st</sup> Century program spaces was considered.

In creating a formula that would help identify the areas most in need of more subsidized services, the Strategic Planning and Needs Assessment Work Group (Work Group) considered the size of the resident population of eligible children and the percentage of those children currently un-served. Formulas for determining priorities varied by age group.

### Infant/Toddlers

For infants/toddlers (zero-to-three), the Work Group determined that to be considered a Priority 1 zip code, the population threshold for eligible children is 200; and the percentage un-served is 25% or more. Priority 2 zip codes have a threshold of at least 100 children and 25% or more un-served. All other zip codes have no priority for funding.

For preschool-age children (three through five), the Work Group determined that to be considered a Priority 1 zip code, the population threshold for eligible children is 300; and the percentage un-served is 50% or more. Priority 2 zip codes have a threshold of at least 300 children and 25-49% are un-served. All other zip codes have no priority for funding.
