

“TREE FIRE” UPDATE

Wednesday, May 9, 2012 – 0900

At approximately 4 p.m. on Tuesday, May 8, 2012, a three-alarm brushfire broke out at Soledad Canyon Road and Bootlegger Canyon Road located in the unincorporated area community of Acton (Thomas Guide 4464, H-7). Water dropping helicopters and 375 firefighters from the U.S. Forest Service and L.A. County Fire Department battled the brushfire is that is now 100% contained (total of 126 acres burned).
