MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

MARCH 7, 2016

1. Call to Order.

This meeting of the County of Los Angeles Claims Board was called to order at 9:30 a.m. The meeting was held in the Executive Conference Room, 648 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California.

At 11:36 a.m., the Claims Board reconvened in open session and reported the actions taken in Closed Session as follows:

- a. Adrian Scott Morgan v. County of Los Angeles, et al.
United States District Court Case No. CV 08-8357-ODW

This lawsuit alleges deliberate indifference to an inmate's medical needs while he was incarcerated at Men's Central Jail.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$175,000.

- b. Desiree Henriquez, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.
United States District Court Case No. 2:14-CV00196-GW

This wrongful death lawsuit arises from the death of an accident victim that was treated by Los Angeles County Fire Department paramedics.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$925,000.

Vote: Ayes: 3 – John Naimo, Steve Robles, and Roger Granbo

- c. Non-Litigated Claim of Victor Sevilla

This claim seeks compensation from the Department of Public Works for real and personal property damage allegedly caused from a backflow of sewage due to a sewer mainline blockage.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$99,500.

- d. Non-Litigated Claim of Steven Shvarts and Yuquian Cai

This claim seeks compensation from the Department of Public Works for real and personal property damage allegedly caused from a backflow of sewage due to a sewer mainline blockage.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of this matter in the amount of \$59,643.43.

- e. Non-Litigated Claim of Roohi Pinhassian and Avraham Pinhassian

This claim seeks compensation from the Department of Public Works for real and personal property damage allegedly caused from a backflow of sewage due to a sewer mainline blockage.

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$58,643.83.

- f. Dalai International Corporation v. County of Los Angeles, et al.

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$24,999.

- i. Alisa Medders v. County of Los Angeles

The Claims Board approved settlement of this matter in the amount of \$50,000.

- j. Francisco Coronado v. County of Los Angeles


