NOTICE OF CLOSED SESSION

Close Session – Conference with Legal Counsel – Existing Litigation (Subdivision (a) of Government Code Section 54956.9).

CS-1 Marco Ferreira v. County of Los Angeles SC 105370

This is a single motorcycle roadway accident resulting in serious injuries that occurred near a sharp curve on Piuma Road. It is alleged that a dangerous condition of road existed at the time of the incident.

CS-2 Avetisyan v. County BC 396962

This is a single automobile accident where decedent driver, Avetisyan, lost control of his vehicle and slammed sideways into a guardrail end treatment. It is alleged that the guardrail end treatment was incorrectly design and installed.

CS-3 Rory Roderick v. County MC 019320

This is a single automobile accident on Angeles Forest Highway with no witnesses resulting in quadriplegia. It is alleged that a dangerous condition of roadway existed at the time of the incident.

CS-4 Frank Nelson v. County of Los Angeles TC024128

This is a trip and fall claim with no witnesses resulting in quadriplegia at a County Bus Shelter near the corner of Vermont and 110th street. It is alleged that a dangerous condition of the shelter existed at the time of the incident.

CS-5 Inge Wiersema v. County of Los Angeles, et al.
Los Angeles County Superior Court Case No. SC 097 130

This dangerous condition lawsuit arises from personal injuries sustained in a bicycle accident which occurred on Pacific Coast Highway; settlement is recommended in the amount of \$390,000.
