Presentations:

Sheriff's Deputy Jose Ovalle is commended for rescuing a motorist trapped in a burning vehicle on the Golden State Freeway on April 13.

Basketball team and Coach Manuel Gonzales of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church are honored for winning the 2004 Catholic Youth Organization basketball championship.

Public Hearings:

Supervisors asked to approve \$6.2 million agreement to rehabilitate various public housing developments in the County. (Items 1-H and 22, continued from 5-18)

Consideration given to increasing sewer service charge to \$22.50 from \$17.50, car impound fees by \$15, and street lighting fees to \$17 from \$5 in two areas. (Item 1, 4 and 5)

Board asked to approve \$73.4 million in community block grant funding for projects in the Community Development Commission's 2004-05 action plan. (Items 2, 1-D, and 2-H)

Various park and recreation fee increases proposed, including establishing a \$100 non-motorized annual boat pass fee and \$2 swim fee for Castaic Lake, Bonelli Regional Park and Santa Fe Dam Recreational Area. (Item 3)

Approval sought for \$203,110 purchase of 28.11 acres of property in the north-central portion of the Santa Monica Mountains and 55-year management agreement. (Item 8)

Change in zoning sought for property at 11400 Poema Place, Chatsworth, from non-urban to low density residential for development of 65 condominium units and removal of one oak tree. (Item 12)

Agenda Items:

Supervisor Michael D. Antonovich seeks recommendations for policy changes related to dumping medical waste in Sunshine Canyon Landfill. (Item 14)

Supervisor Don Knabe asks supervisors to approve drafting of ordinance that automatically disqualifies from County employment any applicant convicted of workers' compensation fraud. (Item 19)
