#### **Presentations:**

Four former foster youth are honored for graduating from career development program operated by the County's Internal Services Department.

Scroll presented to World War II Air Force pilot Flora Belle Reece, who recently fulfilled lifelong dream of riding in P-38 aircraft.

#### **Agenda Items:**

Supervisors asked to approve issuance of maximum \$6 million in bonds to finance development of 75-unit senior citizen affordable housing development at 15554 Gale Ave. in Hacienda Heights. (Items 5-H and 17)

Approval sought to reallocate excess regional park and open space district funds in the amount of \$9.7 million for various County projects. (Item 1-P)

Supervisors Zev Yaroslavsky and Gloria Molina seek study on ways to utilize County's homeless funds for a comprehensive homeless delivery system. (Item 5)

Consideration given to banning smoking on public beaches in County unincorporated areas. (Item 6)

Beaches and Harbors Department requests approval to terminate restroom cleaning contract for failure of contractor to pay employees in compliance with County's living wage ordinance. (Item 14)

Board asked to approve \$11.2 million agreement for domestic violence services to welfare recipients, and \$13 million contract for enhanced employment services to General Relief recipients. (Items 20 and 21)

Authorization sought to accept \$1.2 million in state funding to upgrade Fire Department's 911 system and enhance its ability to answer 911 cellular calls using a global positioning and mapping system. (Item 24)

Department of Human Resources seeks approval of agreement with City of Los Angeles for County to provide management development training programs to city

employees at its training academy. (Item 33)

Public Library requests adoption of resolution to set the voter-approved special tax rate at \$25.22 per parcel from previous \$24.76. (Item 40)

Board asked to approve \$600,000 proposal for grant to provide transportation services to residents in rural areas of North County. (Item 48)

Sheriff's Department requests approval of application to federal government seeking portion of \$8.3 million available to state, with no County match required, to improve DNA analysis and identify and test backlogged forensic cases. (Items 56 and 57)
