FINAL ACTIONS -- NOV. 3

(Vote was unanimous unless otherwise indicated.)

Proposal presented to purchase 120 acres in Calabasas Peak area of Santa Monica Mountains for \$1.5 million to protect open space and preserve native plant and wildlife habitat. (Items 1P, 2P and 9)

Supervisor Gloria Molina recommends a county medical clinic building in Bell Gardens be transferred at no cost to JWCH Institute Inc. to provide outpatient health care. (Item 2)

Supervisors Michael D. Antonovich and Zev Yaroslavsky propose creation of a council to improve education for foster and probation youths. (Item 3)

Recommendation calls for supervisors to hold one of their monthly meetings in different supervisory districts. (Item 6, continued from 10-26) **REPORT ORDERED ON OPTIONS AND COSTS**

Fire Department asks for three-year \$468,000 contract to develop program to assist employees cope with stress. (Item 12) **DEPARTMENT CONTINUED 1 WEEK**
