MOLINA MOTION TO INSTRUCT CAO TO DEVELOP PLANS TO REDUCE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COSTS AND TRACK EFFECTIVENESS

Board asked to authorize issuance of \$205 million in notes for capital projects to replace vehicle license fees diverted by the state, which the state is obligated to repay by Aug. 15, 2006. (Items 1-F and 55)

Supervisor Don Knabe recommends suing City of Los Angeles if it gives final approval to the LAX master plan and certifies the environmental impact report. (Item 4)

Reconvening of task force proposed to make recommendations to further reduce the number of babies that are abandoned. (Item 5)

Board asked to authorize payment of \$10,000 reward to individual that provided information to Sheriff's Department that led to conviction of Christian Humphreys for vandalizing and stealing three angel statues from Lancaster Cemetery. (Item 8)

Responding to significant demand and use by departments, Board is asked to expand risk management and claims data computer project to \$15 million from \$6.6 million. (Item 9) **CAO CONTINUED FOR 1 WEEK**

Proposal would require 1 percent of design and construction costs on new County capital projects and certain refurbishments to be allocated for public art. (Item 14) **4-1, ANTONOVICH VOTING NO**

Board asked to submit application for \$447,345 federal grant set aside to assist in constructing new library in La Crescenta. (Item 27)

Health Services outlines plans to integrate/consolidate hospital and clinical services. (Item 51)
