FINAL RESULTS: June 13 Meeting

(Unless otherwise indicated, vote was 4-0. Supervisor Knabe was absent.)

Board reviews in closed session lawsuit concerning allegations that Department of Public Social Services employee was subjected to racial harassment and discrimination. (CS-1, cont. from 6/7)

Board reviews in closed session lawsuits by contractors seeking additional compensation for construction services on Walt Disney Concert Hall. (CS-2) **SETTLEMENT APPROVED**

Los Angeles Child Guidance Clinic honored for receiving the American Psychiatric Association 2006 National Mental Health Award.

Board asked to adopt 2006-07 \$136 million budget for Community Development Commission and \$277 million budget for the Housing Authority. (Items 1-D, 1-H) **APPROVED**

\$300,000 proposal would purchase 143 acres of tax-defaulted land within Santa Clarita/Antelope Valley for public park/open space purposes. (Item 1-P) **APPROVED**

Motion asks strategy and public awareness campaign be developed to combat and prevent the spread of syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases, with report on lessons learned from the last \$1 million outreach campaign. (Item 2) **APPROVED**

Extension of \$10,000 reward recommended for information leading to arrest/conviction of individual(s) responsible for the murder of Fermin Cardenas in Baldwin Park on Dec. 6, 2005. (Item 7) **APPROVED**

Extension of \$25,000 reward recommended for information leading to arrest/conviction of individual(s) responsible for murder of Robert Whitehead in West Valinda on March 9. (Item 8) **APPROVED**

Supervisor Gloria Molina proposal would encourage the development of the Emerald Necklace, a 17-mile network of non-motorized multi-use trails which would include equestrian, hiking and bike paths along the Rio Hondo and San Gabriel Rivers. (Item 9) **APPROVED**

Extension of \$10,000 reward recommended for information leading to arrest/conviction of individual(s) responsible for the murder of Johnny H. Brown II in Inglewood on Dec. 4, 2005. (Item 11) **APPROVED**

Proposal would transfer 18 acres of La Mirada Regional Park to City of La Mirada in exchange for the city building a new aquatic center housing two pools, spa, and family fun area. (Item 17) **APPROVED**

Board asked to approve easement exchange with operators of County Museum of Art for open space parkland and construction of new buildings and underground parking structure. (Item 18) **APPROVED**

Board asked to review final EIR for the Hall of Justice renovation project, with assurances that numerous historic features of the building will be preserved. (Item 19) **APPROVED**

Board votes to give final approval to development by residential group home in Altadena, including removal of two oak trees. (Item 22) **APPROVED**

Recommendation would establish County Police Explorers program at parks, providing a career education opportunity to qualified youth. (Item 29) **APPROVED**

\$270,000 proposal would develop centralized database to track small-business contracts and target businesses that might compete for county contracts. (Item 30) **APPROVED**

County would save \$792,000 annually by using recycled water to irrigate Whittier Narrows Recreation Area in Rosemead/South El Monte. (Item 34) **APPROVED**

Board asked to increase tax levy for libraries to \$26.23 from \$25.72. (Item 37, cont. from 5/30) **CONTINUED TO JUNE 20**

\$6.3 million proposal would fund tenant improvements at new Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk warehouse service center and provide architect/design services for planned renovations. (Item 43, cont. from 5/30) **APPROVED**

\$3.2 million proposal would make improvements at El Cariso Regional County Park, including renovating play areas, walkways, and picnic tables. (Item 45) **APPROVED**

Proposal would allow building of bike path along Los Angeles River in Los Angeles. (Item 51) **APPROVED**

Board asked to adopt the San Gabriel River Corridor Master Plan, which encompasses 130 projects designed to enhance habitat, recreation and open space. (Item 53) **APPROVED**

\$425,000 and \$325,000 settlements proposed for two women who claimed they were sexually assaulted by a sheriff's deputy during traffic stops. (Item 61, 62, cont. from 5/30) **APPROVED**

Supervisors asked to approve settlement to debar vendor from bidding on, being awarded and/or performing work on any contracts from the County for 10 years after vendor pleaded no contest to forgery involving County contract he was awarded. (Item 64) **APPROVED**
