### Final Actions: June 10 Agenda Highlights

(Unless otherwise indicated, vote was 5-0.)

Board asked to approve \$439 million budget for FY 2008-09 for Community Development Commission and Housing Authority, and incorporate 5% pay increase of the top salary ranges for all classifications/levels. (Items 1-D, 1-H) **APPROVED**

Proposed agreement would allow for the administration of \$19.8 million in loans to developers to increase the construction/supply of affordable housing in the County. (Item 2-D) **APPROVED**

\$750,000 proposal would fund acquisition/relocation consulting services for housing/economic/environmental/redevelopment projects in the County. (Items 3-D, 2-H) **APPROVED**

Acceptance of \$450,000 grant would fund program to promote independent living for up to 1,429 seniors and persons with disabilities living at 14 public housing sites throughout the County. (Item 6-H) **APPROVED**

Supervisor Don Knabe requests adoption of interim urgency ordinance to temporarily require a conditional use permit in the Cerritos Island area for construction of residential buildings over 26 feet tall and for yard modifications, and set July 22 for public hearing to consider extension of ordinance. (Item 3, 58) **APPROVED**

Board asks Acting Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk Dean Logan to provide analysis in 30 days of the June 3 primary election. (Item 4) **APPROVED**

Supervisor Michael D. Antonovich requests report in 60 days about the current zoning regulations/restrictions pertaining to wineries and consider modifying the ordinance to promote business, tourism and jobs. (Item 8) **APPROVED**

Proposed contract amendment with the state would allow transfer of \$1 million to the City of Los Angeles to help fund construction of the Children's Museum of Los Angeles. (Item 14) **YAROSLAVSKY CONT. TO 6/17**

Approval sought to enter into various agreements with state agencies/project partners to secure \$115 million to fund development of housing for the mentally ill and their families. (Item 25) **APPROVED**

Proposal would increase the special tax for libraries to \$27.29 for FY 2008-09 for single-family residences located in the areas that are subject to the special tax, a 2 % increase over the current rate of \$26.75. (Item 33) **APPROVED**

\$773,500 proposal would fund computer upgrades to the County's Consolidated Criminal History Reporting System, which is outdated and obsolete. (Item 57) **APPROVED**

Supervisor Yvonne B. Burke asks that departments present report in 60 days on feasibility of implementing homeless plan for older adults. (Item 62-A) **APPROVED**

Report requested on options to update County's telecommuting policy and other recommendations to decrease transportation costs for employees while preserving public access to services. (Item 62-B) **APPROVED**

Recommendations requested on ways to conserve water. (Item 62-C) **APPROVED**
