## Final Results: June 17 Agenda Highlights

(Unless otherwise indicated, vote was 5-0.)

Valencia High School men's volleyball team recognized for winning the CIF-Southern Section Division II championship.

Report scheduled on financial status of the Health Services Department. (Item S-1, 11:30 a.m.)

**RECEIVED AND FILED**

Budget deliberations are set for 2 p.m. should the Board not adopt the budget on Monday.

**APPROVED BUDGET 5-0, WITH MOLINA VOTING AGAINST \$500,000 FOR FIVE ADDITIONAL EMPLOYEES TO CONDUCT IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT INTERVIEWS IN THE JAILS. APPROVED MOLINA MOTION TO PLACE \$33 MILLION IN EFFICIENCY SAVINGS FROM THE KING MULTI-SPECIALTY AMBULATORY CARE CENTER INTO PROVISIONAL FUNDING ACCOUNT AND \$3.2 MILLION FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP CLINICS. APPROVED YAROSLAVSKY MOTION TO BUDGET \$159,000 FOR EROSION AND SLIDE REPAIRS ON HOLLYWOOD BOWL PROPERTY. APPROVED BURKE MOTION TO TRANSFER \$400,000 TO SECOND DISTRICT COMMUNITY PROGRAMS BUDGET.**

Board asked to approve environmental impact report, site acquisition, and allocation of \$7.4 million in funding for construction of a 60-unit affordable multi-family rental housing development in East Los Angeles. (Item 6-D) **REFERRED BACK BY MOLINA**

\$738,859 proposal would fund expansion of public website that provides affordable housing listing service for landlords, residents, and housing locators and caseworkers. (Item 7-D) **REFERRED BACK TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION**

Extension of \$10,000 reward proposed by Supervisor Yvonne B. Burke for information leading to arrest and conviction of person(s) responsible for the March 28 murder of Clifton Hibbert, Jr. and Kenneth Patterson in Los Angeles. (Item 4) **APPROVED**

Supervisor Gloria Molina recommends reestablishment of \$10,000 reward for information leading to arrest and conviction of the two men who set Marcial Sanchez on fire as he was standing on sidewalk on Cesar Chavez Boulevard on Oct. 7, 2007. (Item 7) **APPROVED**

Board asked to approve contract amendment with the state to transfer \$1 million to the City of Los Angeles to help fund construction of the Children's Museum of Los Angeles, as well as

acceptance of environmental impact report. (Item 9, cont. from 6/10) **APPROVED**

Approval sought to develop countywide “Gangs and Violence Reduction Plan” designed to reduce gang violence through youth/family integration programs and gang intervention strategies. (Item 10) **REFERRED BACK TO CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICE**

Board asked to approve substitution of properties pledged under County’s tax-exempt commercial paper program to remove courts so they may be transferred to state. (Item 12) **APPROVED**

\$2.3 million proposal would fund implementation of computer system designed to assist in the preparation/tracking of County employee performance evaluations. (Item 19) **APPROVED**

Retroactive contract proposed for financially troubled Tri-City Mental Health Center to enhance services for Pomona, Claremont and La Verne residents and enable it to pay some of its debts. (Item 30, cont. from 5/13, 5/20, 6/4) **APPROVED**

Board asked to support application designating the unincorporated area of Florence-Firestone and/or Willowbrook as a state enterprise zone. (Item 39) **APPROVED**

\$837,500 proposal would replace the practice area and irrigation system at the Maggie Hathaway Golf Course in Athens. (Item 40) **APPROVED**

Maximum \$974,342 proposal would fund three-year consulting contract for work related to updating the County General Plan. (Item 41) **CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICE CONT. TO 6/24**

\$10.1 million appropriation adjustment would fund construction of high-priority streetscape improvement projects in the First District. (Item 43) **APPROVED**

Board asked to approve various electrical system/remodeling/consulting upgrade projects as part of the \$344.1 million Harbor-UCLA Medical Center Surgery/Emergency Replacement Project. (Item 48) **APPROVED 4-1, WITH MOLINA OPPOSING**

Recommendation calls for Sheriff’s Department to assume administration of contract for remedial activities at Santa Clarita Station to provide for aggressive groundwater remediation necessary for site closure. (Item 59) **APPROVED**

\$1 million proposal would fund improvements to the Sheriff’s Emergency Vehicle Operations Center at the Fairplex in Pomona, including track upgrades and installation of a modular office building. (Item 60) **APPROVED**

Report scheduled on the compensation issues that may arise with SEIU Local 721 in connection with the next contract as it relates to In-Home Supportive Services; and how the governor’s proposed budget would affect the County General Fund if approved. (Item 73) **RECEIVED AND FILED**

Supervisor Michael D. Antonovich recommends \$10,000 reward be established for information leading to arrest and conviction of person(s) responsible for murder of Hsiao Hong Hsu, who was shot and killed March 19 in her Covina Hills home while on the phone with police dispatchers reporting a break-in. (Motion brought in at meeting.) **APPROVED**

Board in closed session discusses lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of the County's utility user tax ordinance. (CS-1) **NO REPORTABLE ACTION**
