This lawsuit concerns allegations of excessive force shooting and wrongful death by Sheriff's Deputies.

The Contract Cities Liability Trust Fund Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$875,000 and that the Auditor-Controller be instructed to draw a warrant to implement this settlement from the Sheriff's Department budget.

The vote of the Contract Cities Liability Trust Fund Claims Board was unanimous with all members present.

- b. M.L., a minor, at al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.
Norwalk Superior Court Case Nos. VC058338

This lawsuit concerns allegations of excessive force shooting by Sheriff's Deputies.

The Contract Cities Liability Trust Fund Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$311,500 and that the Auditor-Controller be instructed to draw a warrant to implement this settlement from the Sheriff's Department budget.

The vote of the Contract Cities Liability Trust Fund Claims Board was unanimous with all members present


