Background

MYLES MESHACK County Project Manager

- On November 3, 2020, the voters of Los Angeles County (County) approved Measure J which amended the County's charter to require that the County set aside at least 10% of the County's locally generated unrestricted revenues to be used for direct community investment and alternatives to incarceration.
- One week later, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors' (Board) adopted Measure J, and created the Measure J "Re-Imagine LA" Advisory Committee which was charged with soliciting public opinion and developing spending proposals for the Measure J investments

- On June 17, 2021, the Los Angeles Superior Court tentatively ruled that Measure J is constitutionally invalid as it interferes with the Boards' authority under State law to establish the County's budget. However, the decision does not prevent the Board from adopting a budget in line with Measure J's provisions. Following this ruling, the County began referring to Measure J as "Care First Community Investment" (CFCI).
- On August 10, 2021, the Board adopted a motion officially disbanding the Measure J "Re-Imagine LA" Advisory Committee and creating the new Care First and Community Investment Committee.

- Also in August 2021, the Board approved the CFCI Fiscal Year 2021-22 Spending Plan which allocated the \$100 Million in funds for Measure J/CFCI Advisory Committee recommended programs.
- The Spending Plan also leveraged an additional \$87.7 Million on American Rescue Plan Funds to further support Committee recommended programs.

- During the process of developing spending recommendations, the public consistently complained that the County had not performed enough community outreach. Through final meetings leading up to the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Spending Plan, individuals claimed that they had just been made aware of the CFCI process.
- In response to the community request, the Board directed the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to retain the services a professional facilitator or consultant with expertise in racial equity, serving communities of color and low-income communities and in leading robust community engagement processes.
