1. Be respectful
2. Be mindful of power dynamics
3. Be mindful of the diverse audience you're presenting to and make sure you speak with clarity
4. Be collaborative
5. Assume best intentions
6. Have respectful dialogue between community and county
7. Be open-minded and set aside judgement and criticism
8. Challenge the idea, not the person
9. Remember why we're here
10. Defer to community
11. Transparency and follow-through
12. Be intentional about hearing and allowing space for additional voices to be uplifted
13. Make sure there's space for people to feel comfortable asking questions
14. Create opportunities for alternates
15. Be committed and consistent
16. Arrive on time
17. Don't be distracted or a distraction
18. Try to be succinct in your thoughts and contributions
19. Let equity lead the way
20. Be prepared
21. Make spaces for youth voices
22. Review community agreements before every meeting and amend them as needed
