ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. First-time applicants must reside within Los Angeles County.
- 2. Students must attend an accredited university, community college, or post-secondary certification program and provide proof of enrollment.
- High school seniors (12th graders) must graduate with their high school diploma or GED by June 2023 and attend a university, community college, or vocational/trade school in Fall 2023.
- 4. Student applicants must have a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- 5. Prior applicants can reapply and be considered by verifying continued enrollment in an academic or vocational program.
- 6. Continuous applicants enrolled at a college or university are not required to maintain residency in Los Angeles County to be considered.

A COMPLETED APPLICATION SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ Scholarship application completed Online
- ✓ Two essay statements
- \checkmark Two letters of recommendation
- ✓ Unofficial transcripts, a recent report card, or a screenshot of a class schedule that illustrates the name of the school and the name and contact information of a school representative
