HAZARDS AND THREATS LANDSLIDES, MUD AND DEBRIS FLOWS LANDSLIDE MITIGATION

Mitigation includes any activities that prevent an emergency, reduce the chance of an emergency happening, or lessens the damaging effects of unavoidable emergencies. Investing in preventive mitigation steps now such as planting ground cover (low growing plants) on slopes, or installing flexible pipe fitting to avoid gas or water leaks, will help reduce the impact of landslides and mudflows in the future.
