The Southern California Edison (SCE) Medical Baseline Allocation Program is available if you or a loved one requires the regular use of electrically operated life support equipment in yours and/or loved one’s home. The standard Medical Baseline Allocation according to the Southern California Edison’s brochure is an additional 16.5 kWh per day, billed at baseline rate*.

For Santa Catalina Island gas customers, the standard Medical Baseline Allocation will be 0.822 therms per day.
