



## **Information from “Guide for Metro Riders” brochure**

### **WHAT TO DO IN AN EARTHQUAKE**

- If possible, “Drop, Cover and Hold On” until the shaking stops.
- Stay on board buses and trains or in train stations until instructed to do otherwise by Metro personnel.
- The safest place to be during an earthquake is on the underground Metro system—you may not even know an earthquake has occurred.

### **IF YOU ARE ON A BUS**

- Stay onboard the bus unless instructed to do otherwise by the operator.
- After the shaking stops the operator will stop the bus at the first available safe area away from overpasses, tall buildings, electrical wires or other hazards.
- If it is necessary to evacuate the bus, the operator will survey the situation outside the bus for any unsafe conditions and direct passengers to a safe area.
- Radio dispatch will be monitoring the bus fleet to handle any emergencies, broadcast instructions to the operator and allow them to proceed when safe.
